1. TRANSPORT

Arriving in Oslo, Norway:

- Direct trains from Stockholm, Gothenburg, Bergen and Trondheim
- Ferries from Copenhagen and Kiel
- Flights to OSL (Gardermoen) from major cities in Europe

Transport from the Airport

- Airport Express Train from Gardermoen, airport to the city – every 15 minutes get off at Oslo S for the city centre or Nationaltheatret for the meeting venue: Professorsboligen.
- Regional trains from the airport to the city every 15-20 minutes – (accessed with a 24 hour travel card you can use on alternative transport within the city.)

Local Transport:

Oslo, is a relatively small city one of the nice ways to see the city weather permitting is by walking. However, the city is well connected by Buses/Trains/Metro/Tram/ Ferries

<https://ruter.no/en/journey/the-ruter-app/> buy the 24 hour ticket unless you are planning to stay for a longer duration. The city center is zone 1, and the airport is zone 4. However this ticket can not be used on the airport train. There is a very comprehensive local train system running from Gardermoen airport every 15 minutes.

There are some islands in Oslo Fjord that can be accessed by ferry as part of your 24 hour ticket if you wish to do a bit of sight seeing.
